Resolution to Support Grant Township in the Acquisition of Silver Trails Scout Camp

WHEREAS, The Michigan Crossroads Council of the Boy Scouts of America has sold the Silver Trails Scout Camp at a price of \$1.8 million to a company related with a gravel company.

WHEREAS, The Michigan Crossroads Council of the Boy Scouts made no indication to notify any local unit of government, organization, scouters, or other parties that might want to protect the camp:

WHEREAS, for over a half-century, Silver Trails was owned locally by the former Blue Water Council, serving St. Clair and Sanilac Counties. The camp was financially stable under ownership of the BWC.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Lynn Township Board of Trustee wishes to support Grant Township in their efforts to pursue the acquisition of Silver Trails through State grant funding with County support.
