

RESOLUTION

OF WALES TOWNSHIP

IN SUPPORT TO GRANT TWP. TO AQUIRE SILVER TRAILS PROPERTY

WHEREAS, The Michigan Crossroads Council of the Boy Scouts of America has entertained an offer to sell the Silver Trails Scout Camp at a price of \$1.8 million to a company related with a gravel company ; and,

WHEREAS, The Michigan Crossroads Council of the Boy Scouts made no effort to notify any local unit of government, organizations, scouters, or other parties that might want to protect the camp as continued parkland; and,

WHEREAS, for over a half-century, Silver Trails was owned locally by the former Blue Water Council, serving St. Clair and Sanilac Counties. The camp was financially stable under ownership of the Blue Water Council; and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Wales Township Board of Trustees wish to support Grant Township in their efforts to pursue the acquisition of Silver Trails through state grant funding with support of the county; and,

FURTHER, That Wales Township Clerk be authorized to sign this resolution on behalf of Wales Township.
